

Ohio University School of Nursing Schedule of Course Offerings*

The following course schedule lists all Nursing courses being offered for each start date. Please read the advising review letter you have received from the school of nursing. The advising review letter will tell you which nursing courses you need to take.

Each student should begin with the NRSE 300 (unless your advising review letter states you have received transfer credit for this course). After you complete NRSE 300 you can decide if you want to take 1 nursing course per start or 2. To prevent delays in graduating, students are strongly encouraged to complete courses in the order presented in the carousel and in the course map.

The most direct path to completing the core nursing courses is to enroll in the (a) course. Students pursuing Rapid Completion (taking two courses concurrently) should enroll in the (a) course and the (b) course.

The start dates for each five-week session are listed in the left hand column.
